Ministry in Argentina and Uruguay

Prior to the international travel restrictions tied to the Covid Pandemic, the United Christian Ashrams International Ministry embarked on forming new Christian Ashram experiences in Argentina. A former missionary to Argentina, Doug Ruffle, was leading this expansion of the Christian Ashram ministry. Out of the Argentina Christian Ashram, the Vice-President of the Uruguayan Methodist Church formed a Christian Ashram experience in Uruguay. This summer, Brother Adriano Frattini, Vice President of the Uruguayan Church, invited Brother Doug Ruffle to attend a Christian Ashram in November. At our annual meeting of the United Christian Ashrams International Ministry, Brother Doug and I decided to travel together to Uruguay and then on to Argentina.

Brother Doug and I traveled to Montevideo, Uruguay on November 8 where we had the opportunity to meet with the President of the Methodist Church in Uruguay and to visit several ministry locations where the church is focused on ministry to homeless people and to a community near Montevideo (*Comunidad Sembradores*) that is known for violence and drug use. God is using these ministries to reach people who are struggling in life. They shared the story of one family who was able to leave the life of drug addiction, find employment, and move to a safer area in Montevideo. The family continues to return to the church in *Comunidad Sembradores* in hopes of seeing transformation and new life for their former neighbors.

The Christian Ashram was a fabulous success. We then traveled to Buenos Aires, where we met with the Bishop of the Evangelical Methodist Church of Argentina. Through our conversation and encouragement, we established a date for a 2024 Christian Ashram and began a conversation about training opportunities where we may partner in the future.

Thank you for your prayers as Doug and I traveled. We returned home on November 14.

Microcredit Opportunity

During my trip to Malawi, I visited a rural village where a church community has been created. In my conversation with the church leaders, we determined a need for beginning a Microcredit ministry to help women and men start new businesses or to start farming. I made a commitment with the local pastor to provide a minimum of \$500, but no more than \$1,000 to start the Microcredit. I have three \$100 commitments already made, so I need at least two more people to make a \$100 contribution.
